

9th International Conference on Interactive Computer aided Learning (ICL2006)



This event, which we have been organizing since 1998 in Villach, Austria will take place from 27 – 29 September 2006. In the mean time this conference has been established as one of the most recognised in Europe in this field.

This interdisciplinary conference aims to focus on the exchange of relevant trends and research results as well as the presentation of practical experiences gained while developing and testing elements of interactive computer aided learning. Therefore pilot projects, applications and products are also welcome.

So it aims to bridge the gape between pure academic research and more practical works.

The conference is organized by the **Carinthia Tech Institute, Villach/Austria** in cooperation with:

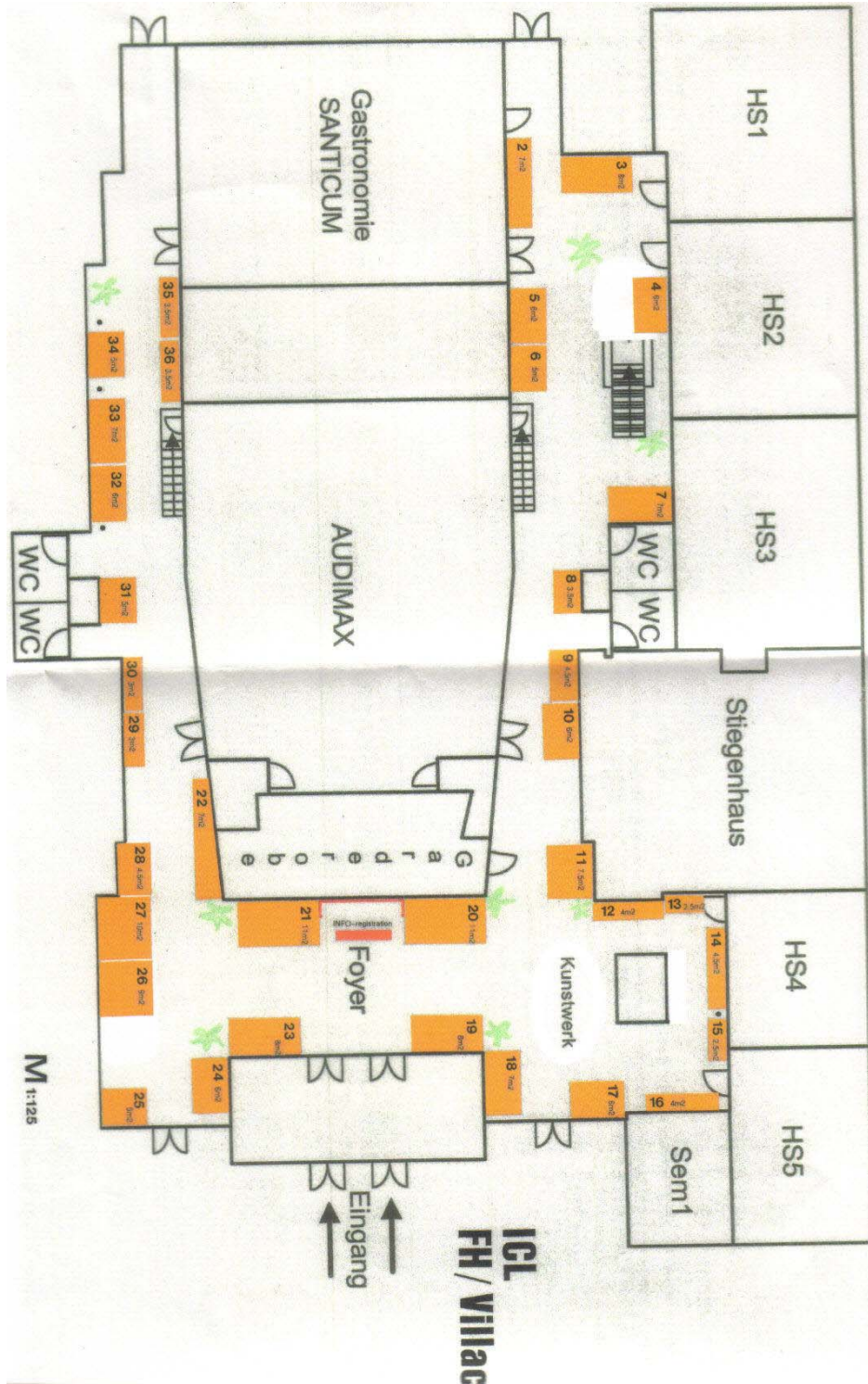
